



## SENSE OF OF COF

## ARCHITECT

Right before the pendemic started, Grant Kirkpatrick, founding partner of KAA. Design, and his wife Shaya completed the total renovation of their kitchen in Manhattan Beach, which had not been touched since the home was built almost 20 years ago. The challenge was to create a new kitchen that still fit in with the rest of the home. For this, the architect worked with the team at Buithaup to create a kitchen with a mix of charcoal gray lower cabinets, high-gloss white upper cabinets, and aluminum backsplash, which gives the kitchen dimension and character.
